Replicate concept maps
Recite word cards
Recite question cards
Practice writing formulas
Work problems
Take self-tests
Practice study guide info out loud
Take notes on re-marked text
Recite list of 20
Do "missed" problems
Recite main points from outline
Recite notes from recall cues
Recite out loud
Re-create chart from memory
Recite steps from memory
Answer essay questions
Practice reciting main points
Write essay answers from memory
Recite answers
Explain material to group members or study partners
